Changes for 15–16 Year End

- ▶ Majority – Mass Change Fields
 - Graduating Seniors
 - HS Completion Credentials
 - Graduation Date
 - All Students
 - Promotion
 - Completed Term
 - Updated July 2016
- ▶ Exceptions – Manual Edits

Changes for 15–16 Year End

- ▶ Mass Exit
 - ▶ Formerly done via WSLS web application
 - ▶ Option no longer available
 - ▶ New JMC Option
 - ▶ Wisconsin–Year End–Mass Exit
 - ▶ Sets exit date and exit code for students who were normally enrolled at end of year
 - ▶ For use in WSLS Exit/Update and ISES Year End Files

Changes for 15–16 Year End

- ▶ Mass Exit Details
 - ▶ Graduating Seniors – HSC
 - ▶ Students less than 6 years old on last day of school – BCA
 - ▶ All other students – TC

NOTE: assigned automatically but for one grade level at a time

Changes for 15–16 Year End

- ▶ WSLs Exit / Update File (EUT)
 - ▶ Wisconsin – WSLs – Export WSLs Exit/Update File – EUT
 - ▶ New JMC Option
 - ▶ Suggest submitting one grade level at a time
 - ▶ Validation messages (pending)
 - ▶ Race–ethnicity

Changes for 15–16 Year End

- ▶ WSLs Exit / Update File (EUT) Detail
 - ▶ Includes exit date from Mass Exit or from Drop Student
 - ▶ Common Issues:
 - ▶ Contact Name – ampersand (fix pending)
 - ▶ Race–ethnicity

Changes for 15–16 Year End

- ▶ WSLs Exit / Update File (EUT) Process
 - ▶ Fix JMC Validation Issues
 - ▶ Submit File (export, upload)(CSV)
 - ▶ Check on WSLs web application
 - ▶ If errors, fix and resubmit
 - ▶ If no errors, proceed to ISES Year End

Changes for 15–16 Year End

- ▶ ISES Year End File
 - ▶ Wisconsin – ISES– Export ISES Student Load File Year End – ISL
 - ▶ Updated July 2016
 - ▶ Validation messages
 - ▶ End of Year Day Number (building)
 - ▶ Race–ethnicity (student)

Changes for 15–16 Year End

- ▶ ISES Year End File
 - ▶ Includes exit code from Mass Exit or from Drop Student
 - ▶ Fields of Interest
 - ▶ Completed Term
 - ▶ Promotion
 - ▶ Usual process – submit, fix, resubmit until no errors, acknowledge warnings



New Data Elements

- ▶ Student Data page
 - ▶ State Rpt tab (ongoing)
 - ▶ Third Party – Begin Date
 - ▶ Expected Transfer Education Organization / School
 - ▶ State Assessment Type – Alternate (SATA)

New Data Elements

- ▶ Student Data page
 - ▶ Entry tab
 - ▶ Birth County
- ▶ Edit Student Sensitive / Lunch Data
 - ▶ Economically Disadvantaged

2016–2017 Timelines and Benchmarks

- ▶ WSLs / ISES
 - ▶ District Shut Down 10/7
 - ▶ DPI Shut Down 10/28
- ▶ WISEid Statewide release 8/29
- ▶ WISEdata Ed-Fi API Ready to Accept School Data 9/2, including Public Schools
 - ▶ Will replace ISES/WSLS file uploads except (2016–2017) Discipline, CWCS

WISEid

- ▶ Similar to WSLS
- ▶ Initially will be file export and upload just as in the past
- ▶ Eventually will be automated via Ed-Fi
 - ▶ “Near Real Time” changes reported to WI
DPI

WISEdata

- ▶ Similar to ISES
- ▶ Initially may be mix of batch processes and “Near Real Time”
- ▶ Eventually may be completely automated via Ed-Fi
 - ▶ “Near Real Time” changes reported to WI DPI within minutes (typical)

JMC WISEdata Public School Certification

- ▶ JMC Ed-Fi licensed as of November 2015
- ▶ JMC Certified for WISEid February 2016
- ▶ JMC Certified for WISEdata Choice School March 2016
- ▶ Current Timeline for Public School Certification mid-August 2016
- ▶ Complicated by recent updates to WI DPI Ed-Fi
 - ▶ Most recent batch made available to vendors July 20, 2016
 - ▶ Update was larger than projected
- ▶ Updated timeline – probably late August
